Your uncle visits you in the dungeon to let you out and apologize. On the way to the main floor of the castle, you push him down the stairs. He instantly dies of his injuries.



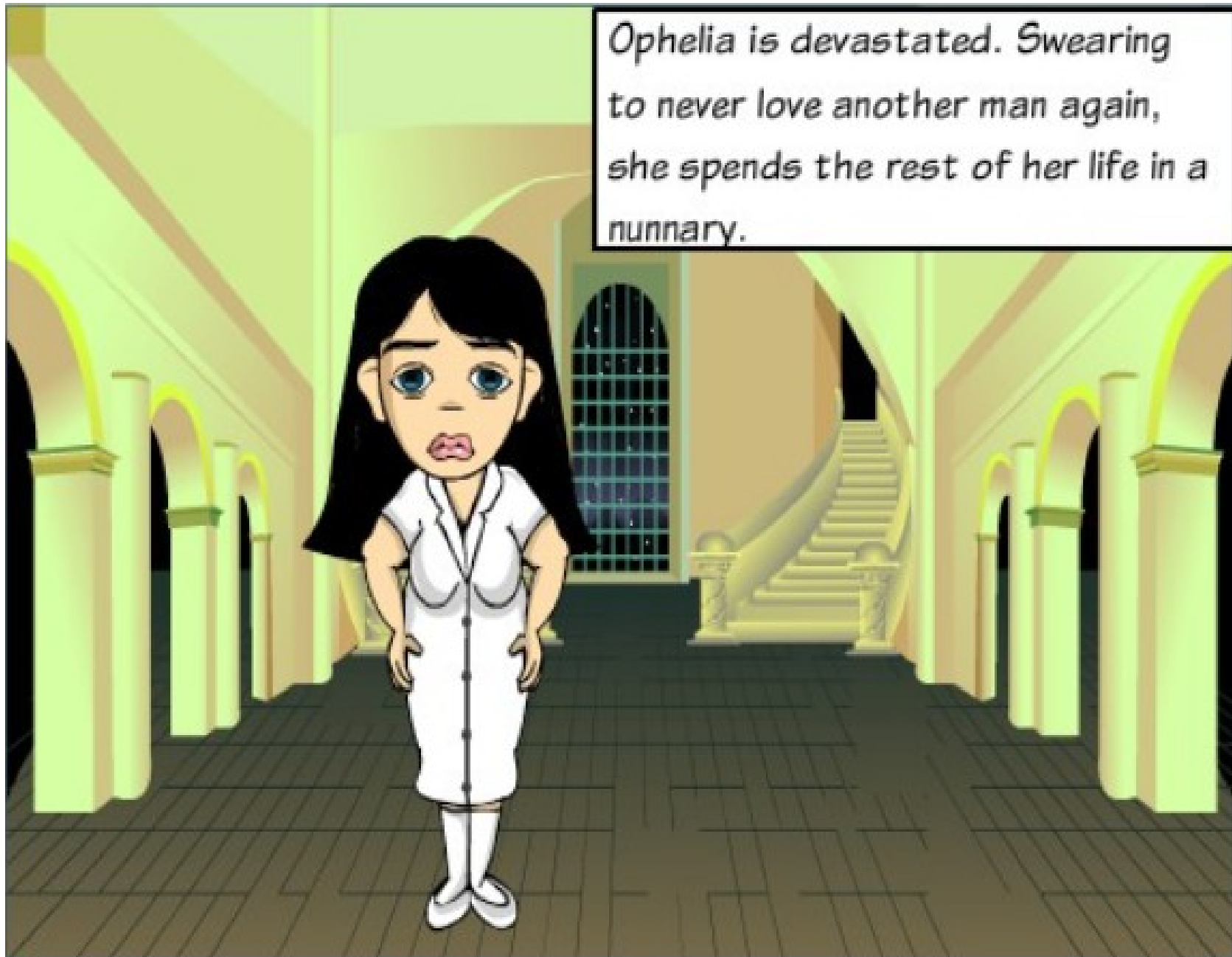

Heartbroken over the murder of her father by her lover, Ophelia goes insane with grief and drowns herself.



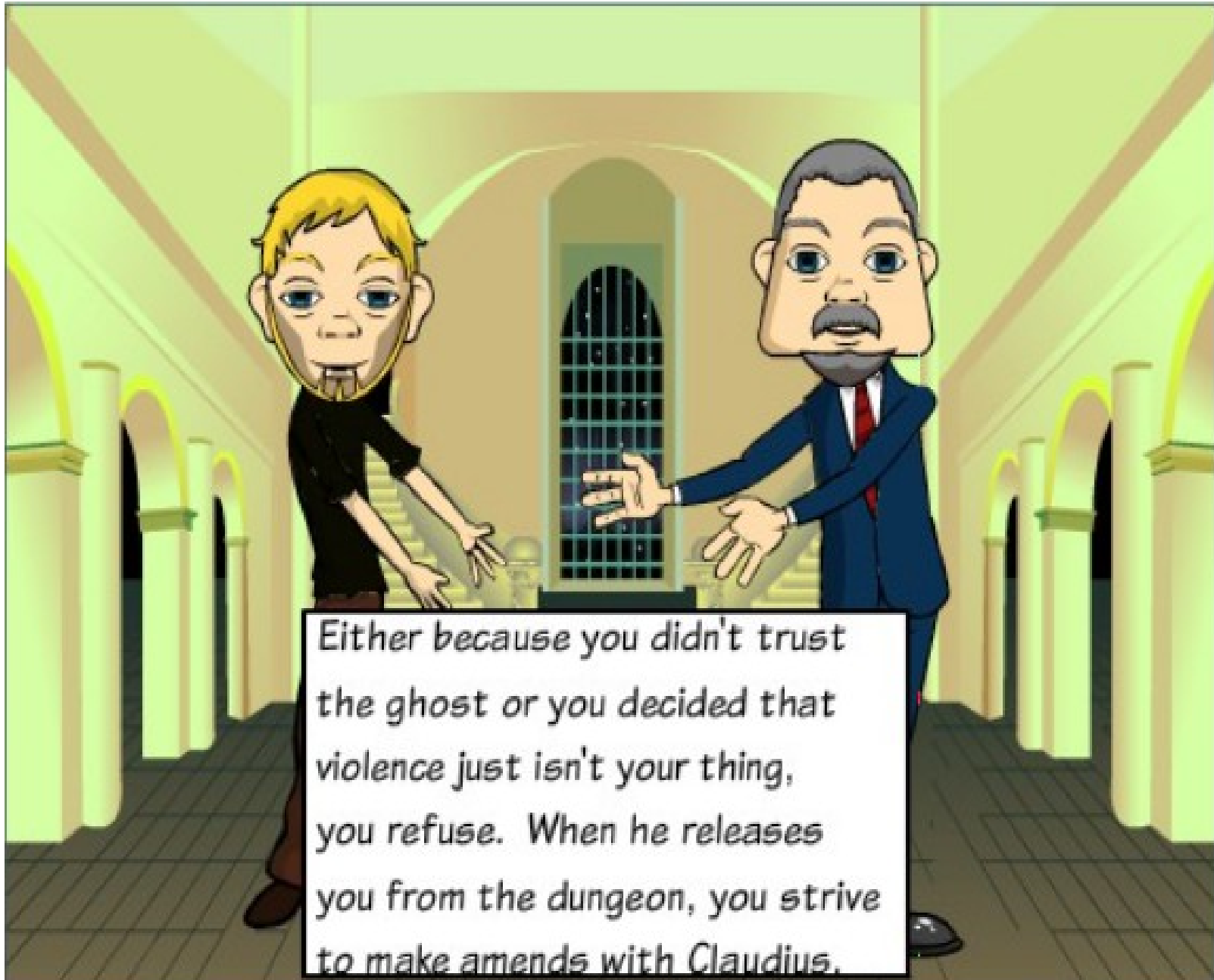
